

Muskogee Crape Myrtle

Lagerstroemia x 'Muskogee'

Category: Deciduous

Growth Rate: Fast

Adaptability: Full sun

Shape: Broad and vase shaped

Size: 20-25' tall, 15-18' wide

Flower Color: Lavender-pink

Description: Muskogee is a mildew resistant hybrid with glossy, elliptic to oblong, dark green leaves that turn red-orange in fall and up to 10" long light lavender-pink flowers from early summer to early fall. The bark is gray to tan and exfoliates with age. Tolerates drought, clay soil and air pollution. This is a single stem specimen.
