

## Chestnut Oak Quercus prinus

Category: Deciduous

**Growth Rate**: Slow to average

**Adaptability**: Full sun **Shape**: Rounded crown

Size: 50-70' tall, 50-70' wide

Fall Color: Yellow-brown fall colors

**Description**: The native chestnut oak is also commonly called basket oak, rock oak and rock chestnut oak. Oval acorns are 1 1/4" long, with warty cups that extend to approximately 1/2 the acorn length. Acorns are an important source of food for wildlife. Generally considered to be a low maintenance tree with good drought tolerance.
