

Persimmon Diospyros virginiana

- Category: Deciduous
- Growth Rate: Average
- Adaptability: Full sun to part shade
- Shape: Pyramidal, rounded oval crown
- Size: 25-50' tall, 15-25' wide
- **Wildlife Value:** Large, fleshy fruit eaten by foxes, raccoons, opossums, and some songbirds
- Fruit/Fall Color: Red and yellowish-green foliage in fall
- **Description**: Tolerates very dry to very wet soils. Edible persimmon fruits (1-2" in diameter) mature in fall to an orange to reddish-purple color, and may persist on the tree into winter. Fruits commonly used in syrups, jellies, ice creams or pies.
