

Yellowwood Cladrastis kentukea

Category: Deciduous

Growth Rate: Slow

Adaptability: Full sun to part shade, can handle drought once

established

Shape: Broad, rounded

Size: 30-50' tall, 40-50' wide

Flower/Fall Color: Showy fragrant flowers, yellow fall leaves

Description: Intensely fragrant, wisteria-like, white flowers will cover a mature tree in late spring. Excellent, low-maintenance, shade tree for residential lawns, particularly on smaller properties. Roots go deep, so other plants may easily

be grown underneath.
