

Nuttall Oak Quercus nuttallii

Category: Deciduous **Growth Rate**: Average

Adaptability: Full sun, grows well in acid or poorly drained

soils and requires minimum pruning.

Shape: Rounded crown; dense **Size**: 40-60' tall, 25-35' wide

Fall Color: Attractive, red to orange fall colors

Description: The ability to grow in marginal environments combined with unrivaled bright red autumn color makes the Nuttall ideal for poorly drained and disturbed urban sites. Acorns ripen from September to October of the second year and fall between September and February.
